

A Second Chance Do Over

Lesson Scriptures: Luke 13:6-9 | **Key Verses:** Psalms 51:10-13

Lesson Objectives:

1. To have a right perspective on receiving a second chance
2. God's forgiveness and restoration process affords us a second chance
3. In this season of second chances we will produce fruit

Lesson Background Info:

This is the parable of the barren fig tree. In this story we see the opportunity to start again. The fig tree has been in the garden for many years, yet it has not produced any fruit on it. The owner of the vineyard wants to cut it down and do away with it. However, the caretaker of the vineyard requests one more year, or one more chance for the fig tree to produce fruit. As we delve into this parable let us understand that there are those that did not make it, and although we did it does not make us better than them. We just have this opportunity to have a second chance to do it right (Luke 13:1-9).

Lesson Action Plan:

1. What can result from having a true repentant heart?
2. In what ways will our repentant heart make an impact on our church?
3. How can you embrace this second chance do over?
4. What kind of fruit should we produce?
5. How does the fruit we produce make an impact for the Kingdom of God?
