

Student Lesson A QUANTUM LEAP TO MY MOUNTAIN TOPS!

KEY VERSE

<u>John 10:10</u> The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

INTRODUCTION

It is Leap Week! This week, together we are preparing to take a Quantum Leap to our mountain tops. Jesus said in John 10:10, "... I am come that they might have life and that they might have it more abundantly." This lesson provides practical steps to use when examining our current position in God to make a quantum leap out of the valleys in our lives and to the mountain top. With all the demands of life, it may feel like where you are is as good as it gets – but in reality, what God has for you far exceeds even your own expectations and understanding. Your valley is not your mountain top. It's time to leap!

Today's Sunday School lesson is about looking at where we are now and making a commitment to take a Quantum Leap in Christ.

WHERE AM I RIGHT NOW? - EXAMINE MYSELF

In John 10:10 Jesus delivers a powerful contrast to the Pharisees of what a true shepherd delivers to his flock and explains that He will give life and that more abundantly.

MORE ABUNDANTLY!

You may have high positions, big titles and influence. BUT that influence will not reach the people but through God! We may not be where we we're supposed to be, even though it may seem as though we are at the highest levels. God wants us to go higher, where we see ourselves today can help us identify what our next mountain top looks like. In fact, what we think is the mountain top, could actually be a valley. It's time to go higher!

A QUANTUM LEAP TO MY MOUNTAIN TOPS!

Now that we are reminded that the valley is not the mountain top, God is calling us higher because we have more – it is time to take the LEAP. Here is a helpful acronym to remember the essential elements included in taking the LEAP in your next steps. It is L-E-A-P.



L - LEAP INTO WHAT GOD WANTS FOR YOUR LIFE

- 2nd Corinthians 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal

E - EVALUATE WHERE YOU ARE AND WHERE GOD WANTS YOU TO BE IN ALL ASPECTS OF YOUR LIFE

- **2 Corinthians 13:5** Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

A - APPLY THE WORD OF GOD AND FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF YOUR SENIOR PASTORS

- **Hebrews 13:17** Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.

P - PRAISE GOD THROUGH YOUR PROCESS

- Psalm 34: 1-3 I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad. O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.

GET SAVED
