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What is a Principle?

A principle is a fundamental truth or proposition that serves as the foundation for a system of belief, behavior or chain of reasoning. It is a fundamental law, doctrine, rule or code of conduct.

Principles are specified traits, ways of engaging life that can enable individuals to live toward their highest potential.

God's Principles:

God presents many principles throughout the Bible that His people are to live by. Although there are too many to put in one lesson, God's principles are established as basic guidelines for Christian character, behavior and success. These principles form a necessary context for Christian living.

These principles include:

- 1. Getting Saved
- 2. Righteous Living
- 3. Operating in Integrity
- 4. Loving Your Neighbor as Yourself
- 5. Coming to Church
- 6. Giving to the Kingdom
- 7. Living a Life of Purpose

The Principles of God vs. the Principles of the World

Most human beings live pretty senselessly—on "autopilot" most of the time. They are for the most part operating by the dictates of the trends, fads and culture that surround them – usually never challenging the mannerisms and principles that are thrusted upon them. Below are listed some common principles versus Godly principles found in the Word of God.

- Lying if you can get away with it vs. Telling the Truth
- Cheater vs. Having Integrity
- Married **vs**. Living Together
- Opposite Sex Relationship vs. Same-Sex Relationship
- Helping Others vs. "Getting Yours" Attitude
- Trusting the Universe (or Science) vs. Trusting God
- Humanism vs. Godly Direction

Common philosophies of secular humanism vs. Biblical Doctrine

- "You do you" philosophy vs. caring about one another (biblical)
- "The world revolves around you" philosophy (narcissism) vs. love your neighbor (biblical)
- "Do things that make you feel good" philosophy vs. Go through to get to (biblical)

We must get back to God and His principle for true success!

What does God Require of Us Concerning His Principles? A Committed Life!

To bring forth "good" success to our lives – we must be transformed through His power and principles. Honoring God's principles must be

done through a life lived. It's a good thing to memorize scriptures and participate in activities – but reverence of His values and principles is going to take a bit more – it's going to take a commitment. A committed life for Christ is when an individual:

- 1. Decides to fully dedicate their ways to God by living Biblical truth
- 2. Follows the Pastoral Teaching given at their Local Church
- 3. Follows guidance of the Holy Spirit that's confirmed by the Word of God
- 4. Yields to God through authentic relationship characterized by humility, sacrifice, prayer and seeking the will of God.
 - <u>2 Chronicles 7:14</u> If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

A committed life happens when a person yields their "flesh" and "wants" and then turns to employ the principles of God in their life.

<u>Romans 12:1-2</u> - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies
of God, that ye present your bodies <u>a living sacrifice</u>, holy,
acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not
conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of
your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable,
and perfect, will of God.
