WHAT IS "THE CHURCH"?

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

According to the New Testament, the church is a "called out" group of believers that:

- take a stand for righteousness (Ephesians 6:13-15)
- assemble together (Hebrews 10:25)
- pray for situations (Matthew 18:19)
- worship corporately (Colossians 3:16)
- fellowship with one another and lead to transform the community that surrounds them. (Mark 16:15)

In this present age, great effort must be given to preserve this Biblical model as the Church labors to get people saved and make disciples for Jesus Christ globally. The Church also must remain a moral compass and be a leading force for righteousness despite the enemy and Kingdom of darkness' efforts to divide and distract the Body of Christ.

WHAT DOES THE CHURCH DO?

We Lead

And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them... (Deuteronomy 28:13)

We take the lead in transforming generations for Christ in our community, region and world. It is our objective to produce a culture of empowerment that will shift the mindsets, mannerisms and ways of believers to a life of righteousness and success in every facet of living. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, Io, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen. (Matthew 28:19-20)
