Unwavering Faith

is what comes to mind when describing the three "Hebrew Boys" of the book of Daniel. In chapter 3 they are self-confessed to be "...not careful..." (16) to answer King Nebuchadnezzar, telling him point blank, that they "...will not serve thy gods, nor

worship the golden image which thou hast set up." (18). In his rage to their protest, the King resorted to his own law and had Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego thrown into a firey furnace for their punishment. And not just any fiery furnace, but in verse 22 it states that the fire was of "exceeding" heat that was so hot, it slew the men that threw the three boys into it. Once thrown in, to the King's astonishment, not only were the boys unscathed by the fire, but he also saw a fourth man walking about the

fire that in his words. "...and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God." After witnessing this the King later called them to come from the fire and said "...Blessed be the God of Shadrach. Meshach. and Abednego..." (28) and also made a decree that any people, nation or language that speaks against their God will be exceedingly punished. They were then promoted by that same King because, of their unwavering faith put into action, it caused a great display of God's power and might.

This month of April, our church's theme is "Growing Strong". And when fully committed, 'Growing' would mean putting forth an action on our part, indicating something to presently take place. Just like the three Hebrew Boys, believing God in the midst of their 'fiery trial', let's us exercise our faith in ways to strengthen us spiritually, and connects us more deeply to the Father. Christ states in John 10: 27-28; "My sheep hear my voice,
