LOCATION: Occoquan Regional Park, 9751 Ox Rd, Lorton, VA 22079. Youth participating in the event will be at **Harvest Life Church** first.

TRANSPORTATION: Harvest Life Church Shuttle Bus

ATTIRE: Black Harvest Life long-sleeved t-shirt, jeans with no holes or cut-off pants, no leggings (girls), no sweatpants (boys), long socks, and close toe shoes, absolutely no crocs or slides.

LOGISTICS: Youth will arrive at Harvest Life Church to check-in and enjoy a light continental breakfast. After prayer and instructions, youth and Youth Staff will board the Harvest Life Church Shuttle to report to Occoquan Regional Park for the Clean-up event. At 11:00 am youth and staff will wrap-up their event and begin loading the Church Shuttle Bus by 11:15 am. Youth and Staff will leave the Park via the Shuttle Bus by 11:40 am to arrive back at Harvest Life Church for 12:00 pm pick-up.
