Answer: He kept Simeon and put him in prison.

Answer: He told them to take:

- Gifts: the best fruits in the land, a little balm, and a little honey, spices, and myrrh, nuts, and almonds
- Double the amount of money they paid for the food
- The money that was in their sacks.

- 1. How did Joseph feel seeing his brother Benjamin for the first time?
- 2. What was one of the things he did? (Gen. 43: 29-30)

Answer 1: His heart yearned upon his brother

Answer 2:

- He entered his chamber, and wept there.
- He washed his face and continued with the meal, but he did not eat with his brothers.
- He sent Benjamin 5 times as much food as he gave the other brothers
- **52. Answer the question.** Why did Joseph tell everybody to get out of his house except his brothers?

Answer: Joseph was about to reveal his identity to his brothers.

53. What was one of the things that happened when everyone left the house except his brothers? (Gen. 45:1-3)

Answers:

- He told them who he was.
- He asked if their father was still alive
- His brothers were worried ("...troubled at his presence")
- **54. Answer the question.** After revealing that he was their brother, what spectacular thing did Joseph say to his brothers to release the guilt from them? (Gen. 45:5-9)

Answer: Joseph told his brothers:

- Don't be angry with themselves, for God sent him before them to preserve their lives from the famine.
- It wasn't them that put him there, God had ordained it
- God has made him a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.

55. Answer the question. When Joseph told his brothers to go get their father, what was one of the things Joseph told his brothers to tell his father? (Gen. 45:9-11)

Answer:

- That God had made him lord of all Egypt: come down unto him, tarry not:
- That they (the father, brothers, generations of their family, their animals...everything they have) would dwell in the land of Goshen and be near him.
- That he would nourish them, because there was five more years of famine.
- **56. Answer the question.** After reading about the story of Joseph and all he went through, would you change any part of his story?

Answer: No
