Lesson Title: Put a Word On It

Key Scriptures: 2 Timothy 3:16-17, Matthew 4:4, 2 Corinthians 10:5

Introduction

We need the Word of God! In John 1:1 the Bible says, “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” The more we learn God’s Word, the more we learn of Him...His ways, His heart, His Spirit.

King David understood this principle well. He said in Psalm 119:11, “Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.” As we learn and memorize scripture, we are building an arsenal that the Holy Spirit can use to shoot down the enemy! When we face situations, the Holy Spirit will bring the Word of God to our remembrance (John 14:26) – but it’s our job to give the Holy Spirit something to draw from.
